## License to Publish

**TO:** *The Journal of Histochemistry & Cytochemistry*, property of and official publication of The Histochemical Society

1. In consideration of the Journal of Histochemistry & Cytochemistry agreeing to publish the Contribution, the Authors (or author in the case of a sole author) grant to JHC the sole and exclusive, irrevocable royalty-free, right to publish, reproduce, distribute, transmit, display, store, translate, perform, create derivative works from and otherwise use the Contribution in any form, manner, format, platform, or medium, whether now known or hereafter developed, throughout the world and in any language, for the entire term of any such right and any renewal or extension thereof and to permit/sublicense to others to any or all of the foregoing as well. Notwithstanding anything to the contrary herein, JHC has no obligation to use the Contribution. In the event that JHC uses the Contribution, JHC shall provide appropriate attribution to The Authors.
